

## Pons Session Commitment Agreement

Consistent attendance, daily participation of the at-home component, review of the multimedia support pages, and the ability to do the neurological patterns independently ensures that participants benefit the most from the sequential curriculum of Brain Highways.

Without such commitment, families quickly get “behind,” thereby requiring extra, individualized assistance from staff during class time. This personalized time then takes away staff interaction with the other class participants. Moreover, the child quickly begins to sense that he or she is not at the same level of the other participants and may begin to feel as though he or she is “failing” Brain Highways.

To prevent the above scenario, I am committed to . . .

- Attending all classes with the exception of cases of illness or family emergency
- Finding time *during the day* (it will keep the child awake if the at-home component is done right before bed) to do the daily 30 minute at-home component
- Turning in each weekly Brainwork Record log (of the time spent creeping)
- Reviewing the multimedia support materials during the week they’re presented
- Completing and turning in questionnaires on time
- Doing more than the daily at-home requirement until my child can do the neurological patterns *without assistance*
- Seeking temporary, extra “helpers” (e.g. a child in the neighborhood, another adult) if, initially, my child needs additional assistance to do the above floor work independently\*
- Finding time to meet with staff (if deemed that my child would benefit from extra assistance) and re-arranging schedules (if necessary) to implement suggested strategies

\*Most children do not require extra assistance; however, some children may initially need two—even three—helpers to effectively “pattern” the participant. Since doing the patterns *independently* is key to the neurological re-organization process, it is extremely important to address this part of the program immediately.

I understand that . . . .

- There are no refunds or credits once enrolled in the class—under any circumstance.
